WA 1440 for Cadet Women - Women under 18 (equivalent to Metric 2)

Note: Archers shooting the WA rounds are eligible for WA Silver Star awards if under 18 in 2019.

Metric 2 - Boys under 16

Metric 3 - Girls under 16 & Boys under 14

Metric 4 - Girls under 14 & Boys under 12

Faces & Arrows 122cm faces at first 2 distances.

per End: 6 zone 80cm faces at 3rd and 4th distances (2 faces per boss)

6 arrows per end in 2 details will be shot throughout the day

Age Groups: Archers should be under 18 and shoot the round appropriate to their age, to be eligible for awards.

Awards: Awards will be made for Surrey archers and visitors for each round. Silver and bronze medals depending on entry.

Entry and Fees: Fee: £12 per Archer. No Refunds from Sunday 26th May 2019.

Bosses: Tenzone layered foam bosses.

Rules: World Archery rules and Archery GB rule 307 (dress regulations) will apply.

Music will be played during the event.

Bows: Compound, Recurve, Longbow and Barebow

Food Food and drinks will be available for breakfast (bacon/sausages etc.). There will be a barbecue at lunchtime. Catering provided by Lintman AC.

Facilities: Toilets are provided on the field.

Smoking/Alcohol: Smoking/Vaping allowed behind the tents only. No alcohol is allowed on the field.

Liability: Neither CSAA or Lintman AC will be liable for damage to cars or other property at the event.

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times.

Drugs: Archers competing at record status tournaments are liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. By entering this shoot the Parent/Guardian is giving consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
