



# County of Surrey Archery Association Surrey Target Championships - 2019



**Event** The 2019 Surrey Target Championships, hosted by Guildford Archery Club

**Date** Sunday, 19<sup>th</sup> May 2019. Registration from 08:00. Assembly 09:45. Practice commences 10:00

**Location** **Note that the location is different from last year!**  
Guildford Archery Club, Manor Fruit Farm, Glaziers Lane, Normandy, Surrey, GU3 2DD

**Rounds** WA1440  
Men: 90m, 70m, 50m and 30m  
Ladies: 70m, 60m, 50m and 30m  
Three dozen arrows at each distance.  
The first six dozen will be shot in two details of six arrows in four minutes on a 122cm face.  
The second six dozen will be shot in two details of six arrows in four minutes on a six-zone 80cm face (barebow and longbows on full 80cm faces).

**Judges** Chairman of Judges: Steve Vallis, assisted by Andrew Trimble

**County Archers** These championships are open to all club archers affiliated to the County of Surrey Archery Association (CSAA). Sorry no archers from outside Surrey this year.

**Rules** World Archery rules and Archery GB rule 307 (dress regulations) will apply. Please don't turn up in blue denim as you will not be allowed to shoot.

**Awards** Recurve Team Cup, Compound Pair Cup, Longbow Pair Cup, Mens and Ladies Recurve Cup, Longbow Cup and Barebow Cup

**Entry and Fees** The entry fee is £10. You can pay by cheque or PayPal but please use the [online booking form](#)  
Note that this is the senior target championships for over 18's only. Details of the junior competition can be found [here](#)  
Archers under 18 years old are welcome but they must shoot as an adult.  
The closing date is 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019. We may still accept entries after this date but as it fills up quickly you are advised to ring 0774 887 1122 before you enter. No refunds after the closing date.

**Target List** A target list will be emailed to all entrants and published on the Surrey Archery website shortly before the event, updated as necessary. The results will be published as soon as possible after the event. Please see [surreyarchery.org](http://surreyarchery.org)

**Archery GB:** Archery GB cards or proof of membership must be shown at registration

**Catering** Tea, coffee and soft drinks will be available all day in the clubhouse kitchen. We will have a light tea available when the shooting has finished.

**Disabilities** Guildford Archery Club are very proud of their award-winning disabled facilities. There is a dedicated disabled parking space, a short solid surface ramp down to the shooting line with a sheltered rest area with a solid surface. Your car will be parked about 80m from the shooting line. There is a disabled toilet in the clubhouse, with level access from the car park. Please let us know if you have any specific requirements.

**Smoking** Smoking, including the use of E-Cigarettes, must be behind the line of tents

**Bosses** You will be shooting at foam bosses

**Dogs** Dogs are allowed on the field but should be kept on a lead at all times

**Car Parking** We have plenty of car parking but please take care when parking so as not to block the exits or anybody in. Remember that some people may have to leave early before the end of shooting. Please don't park in the Normandy Village Hall car park.

**Trophy Return** Winners are responsible for the safe-keeping of their trophies and should return them before shooting begins, cleaned and engraved

**Photography** In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, the organisers of this event request that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close-range photography should register their details with the organisers at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers.
