The competition will be single and double Portsmouth rounds in three sessions:

Awards: Session medals will be awarded for each bow style, gender and senior/junior. Overall medals will also be awarded for county/visitors along with double round, team and handicap awards.
Please declare current Indoor handicap on registration.
Awards presented will vary based on number of archers per group:

- 1-2 archers = Gold medal.
- 3 archers = Gold & Silver medal.
- 5 plus archers = Gold, Silver & Bronze

Entry and Fees: Fee: £16 per session. Refunds will be paid (less admin fees) until the 20th November.
Online entry via Sport80 link: [Archery GB Sport80](#) After login, select Events on the left hand menu, search for Surrey Indoor and select Enter Now.
Number of entrants is limited, places assigned on a first come basis.

Equipment & Target Faces: All Compounds will shoot at 3 spot vertical faces.
Recurve, Barebow and Longbow will shoot at 60cm single faces.

Rules: Archery GB rules of shooting for indoor Shooting with two ends of sighters.
Timing to rule 304(f)(ii). And Shooting to rule 403 plus Equipment Inspection.
Further explanation will be given by your Judges on the day.
Rule 307 (dress regulations) will apply.

Catering A fully operational cafeteria is available in the centre.
