Entry and fees:	Fee: £8, includes Tassel fee. No refunds after Friday 5 th August 2022. Online entry forms available on the Surrey Archery Clout page . In line with our safeguarding policy, junior (<18 years) entries will only be accepted if a person with parental responsibility accompanies the junior and no photography of juniors will be permitted. Anyone wishing to takes photographs must indicate this at registration. Maximum number of entrants is 66. If you find you can not take up your place please inform the organiser asap. In order to compete you must have had prior training/practice of clout archery (AGB Rule 700e). Entry forms include a statement to this effect that must be confirmed by the archer.
